Letter to Parents/Guardians/Caregivers about the 2024 YCDSB Student Census

February 15, 2024

Dear Families,

The York Catholic DSB will conduct the 2024 Student Census to support our mission of educating and inspiring all students to achieve their full potential in a safe and caring environment. All students from our high school will be invited to participate in the voluntary and confidential questionnaire.

The collection of demographic data is a Ministry of Education directive that directs school boards to gather data regularly to help us understand how student achievement is influenced by many factors, including race, ethnicity, gender, socio-economics, engagement, and sense of belonging.

The Student Census will provide our school and the board with information to help us better understand our students and their experiences in school and outside of school. The information provided will help us:

- Understand how learning experiences may differ among groups of students and the connection to their individual life experiences.
- Identify challenges and barriers to help students reach their full potential and achieve success.
- Use programs and resources that reflect students' identities and meet their unique needs.
- Allocate resources where they are needed the most.

The data we gathered from the 2021 Student Census has been used to shape the Multi-Year Strategic Plan, the Student Mental Health & Well-Being Strategic Plan, and board and school improvement plans. It has also helped us to make informed decisions about pedagogy, programs, policies, partnerships, and services.

There are a few important things to note:

- The Student Census is voluntary and confidential but not anonymous, which means that no one will
 view individual responses. However, the census data will be linked to student IDs and matched with
 other student data
- Individual responses will not be analyzed, and the census results will not identify individual students. The reports will only include findings where at least ten or more students have responded.
- All students are encouraged to answer all questions. However, if your child is not comfortable answering a question, they should skip the question and move to the next question.
- No program or report card marks will be withheld from students who do not complete the Student Census.
- Reports will never single out or identify a student or family and will only be reported in summary to provide an understanding of the needs of school communities.

Parents, guardians, and caregivers will receive an email invitation from YCDSB Census (YCDSB@email.sogolytics.com) to participate in the Kindergarten to Grade 5 Parent Census with their child from March 1 to March 22. Students in Grades 6 to 12 will be asked to complete the Student Census in their classrooms with their teacher from March 18 to April 5.

If you do not want your child in Grades 6 to 12 to participate in the Student Census, please complete the appropriate Student Census Opt-out Form below by **February 29**, **2024**, and advise your child's school to ensure that your child does not receive an invitation to participate in the Student Census. Students who do not complete the Census during class time are provided with classroom work at the teacher's discretion.
