
# STEP 1: SELECT COURSES



# **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

## CHOOSE 9+2 ALTERNATES

**Compulsory courses** English - ENG2 History - CHC2 Math - MPM2D or MFM2P Science - SNC2 **Religion - HRE201/3** Civics - CHV2O1 Careers - GLC201

Choose <u>carefully</u> as these will be used to fill in the space (s) if one or more of the courses you choose is cancelled or conflicts.

 HRE2OQ - French Immersion Religion


**NOTE:** Students who are in both FI and AP Prep, <u>need</u> to select CHC2DQ for their History credit.

## MATH COURSE TYPES

Choose carefully...

It is important to choose a Math course type where you will build a strong foundation that will allow you to progress successfully into Gr. 11 and beyond

For example, if you did not do as well as you wished in MTH1W, you can take MFM2P1 in S1 and MPM2D1 in S2 ... or reinforce your skills in summer school

(Graduation Indicator in myBlueprint) Group 1 - Gr. 11 Religion credit Group 2 - 2nd Phys Ed/Art/French, Business, or Co-op Group 3 - Gr. 11/12 Science, 2nd French, Technology, Computer Science, or Co-op Choose your electives CAREFULLY so that you have the correct prerequisites for your anticipated Gr. 11 courses Make sure you have planned for OSSD requirements ... e.g. Phys Ed, Art ... very few Gr. 11 Art courses do not require a prerequisite Explore something NEW!







Once submitted, courses are locked & CAN'T be changed - see Counsellor if there is an issue

- Can I accelerate? (e.g.: take Gr. 10 English and Gr. 11 English)
   Yes you can, however, if space is limited preference will be given to Gr. 11's.
- Should all compulsory courses (Art, Phys Ed, and Groups 1, 2 & 3) be completed by the end of Gr. 10?

Typically, yes but there are exceptions with proper planning.

I find I am struggling in some of my Academic courses and am thinking about changing to Applied.... What doors will I close? What doors will remain open? Depends on pathway! See your Guidance counsellor to discuss and get clarification

## Can I take a mix of course types? Yes, you can!

I took most of my courses at the Applied level and did really well. I would like to take courses next year at the Academic level. Can I do that? Yes, you can!

I can't get a Guidance appointment before I have to hand in my course selection sheet. How am I supposed to get my questions answered?



Course selections are on a first come first serve basis ... submission date may be used to determine enrollment in oversubscribed courses 100% sure that you will <u>NOT</u> be returning to SBA next year ??

Complete your course selection guarantees a timetable if you do decide to return.

School fees will be refunded minus a \$15.00 administration fee.

## Please note...

- Students may take a course only once per school year, unless they change course type
  - For example, if you are unsuccessful in earning an Academic credit in S1, if there is space available, you can take the course at the Applied level in S2
  - Students will not be allowed to retake the course at the same course type...they are welcome to repeat it the following year or take it in summer school (if available)
