

Did you Know?

- Born Alfred, in Quebec on 9 August 1945
 and was orphaned by the time he was 12
 years old
- Had little education and had to work to support himself
- From a very young age, he devoted himself to St. Joseph
- Suffered from poor health and chronic stomach pain all his life, starting at a young age; it was believed he wouldn't survive childhood
- Encouraged by his childhood pastor to consider a religious life and sent him to the Congregation of the Holy Cross with a note: "I'm sending you a saint."
 - Initially rejected by the Congregation due to his poor health and lack of education



Did you Know?

- With the help of the Archbishop of Montreal, he entered the Congregation of the Holy Cross as a Novice/Brother in December 1870, where he took on the name Andre in honour of his pastor
- His primary job was as doorkeeper
- Many who prayed with Brother Andre experienced physical healing and his reputation as a healer spread; in his humility, he attributed these miracles to the intercession of St. Joseph
- He felt a strong desire to increase his devotion to St. Joseph and worked towards the construction of a shrine; he gave 5 cent haircuts to raise funds
- He was released from his doorkeeping duties in 1909 to become the full-time caretaker of St. Joseph's Oratory



"God chose the most ignorant one. If there was anyone more ignorant than I am, God would have chosen him instead of me."

Did you Know?

- Millions of people made pilgrimages to the
 Oratory to see Brother Andre and it became
 his full-time ministry to tend to the sick who
 visited him, earning him the nickname
 "Miracle Man of Montreal"
- Developed plans to construct a larger basilica on the site of the Oratory
- Died on 6 January 1937 at the age of 91 and over a million people arrived at the Oratory to show their respect
- St. Joseph's Oratory continues to be an active site of pilgrimage
- Side chapels contain countless numbers of crutches from people who have been healed through St. Andre's prayers and intercession
- He was canonized on 17 October 2010.







Prayer for the Intercession of St. André Bessette






A Prayer for Acceptance



We make this sign for two main reasons.

- 1. We make the sign of Jesus' Cross over us to show that we understand how much He loved us by dying on the Cross for us. In doing so, He took on our sin and offered salvation.
- 2. We bless ourselves in the name of the Trinity: God the Father who created; God the Son who came as a human being to die on the Cross for us; God the Holy Spirit whose presence and power lives in us.



- Touch your forehead, saying "In the name of the Father";
- 2. Touch the lower middle of your chest, saying "and of the Son";
- 3. Touch your left shoulder, saying "and of the Holy";
- 4. Touch your right shoulder, saying "**Spirit**".

Liturgical Seasons



For Catholics, the liturgical calendar marks the Church year, a sequence of seasons and feasts celebrated in the liturgy during a year's time. Each new year begins with the First Sunday of Advent.





The Meaning of the Advent Candles

Traditionally, the Advent wreath is a circle of evergreen branches. It is often decorated with berries and pinecones. Both the evergreen branches and the circular shape symbolize the passing of time and eternal life. The shape of the wreath, with no beginning or end, reflects the complete and endless love that Jesus has for us. During the Advent season, we eagerly anticipate his coming and the promise of eternal life in heaven with him.

The Four Advent Candles

As a Christian tradition, the wreath holds the four Advent candles. The candles represent Jesus coming as the light in darkness. One candle is lit each Sunday until all four candles are lit. As Christmas draws nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness. Sometimes a white candle is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day to symbolize that Jesus is with us. This can be referred to as the "Christ candle." Each of the candles represents an aspect of preparation during the season of Advent



Week 1: Hope

The purple Prophecy candle is lit. Purple is the primary color associated with Advent.

Within the Catholic Church it symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrifice.

During the first week of Advent we remember the Old Testament prophets who foretold of Jesus' coming with hope and anticipation.

Dear Jesus, you are the hope in our messy world. This Advent, help us slow down, listen to your voice, and focus on what's really important. We place our hope in you as we prepare our hearts to celebrate your birth on Christmas. Amen.



First Week of Advent - HOPE

In this Sunday's Gospel reading we are told to remain watchful and alert. There are so many distractions in our lives that we often miss out on the important things. St. Mark reminds us that we need to be ready for the Lord, as he can come at anytime. This Advent Season, let us wait in joyful anticipation to welcome the Lord into our hearts and homes.




Second Week of Advent - PEACE




Shrove Tuesday Prayer


A Lenten Prayer

The Stations of the Cross


