

To help us to see the light of Christ in all that we serve.


Let us remember that each of us is loved, each of us is willed, and each of us is important.

In the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, Amen.








## ST. BROTHER ANDRÉ CHS LAND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

1 CREDIT IN CANADIAN GEOGRAPHY (GRADE 9)
1 CREDIT IN THE ARTS
1 CREDIT IN HEALTH AND PHYSICAL EDUCATION
1 CREDIT IN FRENCH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE
0.5 CREDIT IN CAREER STUDIES
0.5 CREDIT IN CIVICS AND CITIZENSHIP
1 CREDIT FROM THE STEM-RELATED COURSE
GROUP
