
SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY ONE DONATION AT A TIME

FOOD DONATION CONSIDERATIONS WHAT FAMILIES NEED

- pasta and pasta sauces
- canned soups, stews, chili
- maccaroni and cheese
- canned fruits and vegetables
- canned proteins: tuna, chicken, etc.
- peanut butter or other nut butters
- canned or dried legumes (e.g. lentils, chickpeas)

- granola bars, rice cakes, crackers
- rice white, brown or instant
- flour all purpose or whole wheat
- cooking oils
- salt, sugar and spices
- baking mixes (e.g. muffins, pancakes)
- honey and jams
- coffee and teas
- gluten- and allergenfree options
