




Saint Brother Andre is situated on the ancestral lands and waters of the Anishinaabe, Wendat and Haudenosaunee First Peoples who still walk with us today.



There are countless sports, clubs and councils in which students can participate.


In Grade 9, you will take 4 courses semester 1 concluding with final exams at the end of January.
