


IT'S A SPECIALTY PROGRAM

- 1 credit in FI History Grade 10 grade




THERE ARE NO FI CREDITS IN MATH OR SCIENCE

FI & AP PROGRAM ENROLMENT


- Students can be enrolled concurrently in the FI and AP programs
